







Call for papers

Instructions for authors

These information aims at drafting papers in order to provide appropriate outputs to the edition team.

Topics

Any survey or research works in connection with wind energy and biodiversity can be submitted.

Presentations may address every stage of a wind farm, from preliminary survey to dismantling, including building and repowering; while at the same time, discussions will also cover habitats such as species, direct or indirect damages, and means to assess and reduce them.

The first day of the seminar will be dedicated to onshore wind energy, while the second will focus on offshore wind energy. The presentation should therefore be clearly in connection with the theme of one of these two days.

Public

Wind energy stakeholders, researchers and conservationists

Oral communication

The communications should last 30' (roughly 20-25' for presentation and 5-10' including exchanges with the audience).

Submission format

Speakers should submit a file under .odt or .docx) providing the following information:

- Title with possibly a subheading
- Author(s), organisation and mail
- English and French abstracts (maximum 1 500 characters)
- The French or English paper should be structured that way :
 - Motivation, tested assumptions and aims
 - Methodology
 - Summary outputs
 - $\circ \quad \text{Interpretation, findings, prospects and possible developments} \\$

Selection process

All submissions will be reviewed to select 9 items regarding onshore and offshore wind energy papers.

The selection will be based according to the following criteria:

- Title: connected with the topic covered by the seminar
- Originality and innovation of the proposed paper
- Contribution to improve environmental integration of the wind farms.
